Requirements for MSA Drag & Gymkhana racing events at Killarney 2010:

2010 Motorsport SA License's:

Drag racing at Killarney will be split into the following categories:

Club Championship Drags	(Quicker than 13.000 and WPMC Club members)
Streetcar Drags	(13.000 sec and slower streetcars)
Streetbike Drags	(open)

The 2010 MSA Club licence cost is R300.

Club Championship Drags MSA licence info:

Any car running quicker than 13.000 quarter mile times are required to be WPMC Club members (R660) and have an MSA Club licence (R300) as well as medical cover. If your medical aid covers you for high risk sports please get a letter from them explaining this. If not, MSA medical cover is available at R285 from MSA.

Streetcar Drags MSA licence Info:

Streetcars that do not go quicker than 13.000 are required to have an MSA Club licence (R300). You need to be a member of a club and you are welcome to join the WPMC temporary membership list as approved by the WPMC on completion of 2010 WPMC temporary membership application form and indemnity.

Streetbike Drags MSA licence info:

Streetbikes are required to have an MSA Club licence (R300). You need to be a member of a club and you are welcome to join the WPMC temporary membership list as approved by the WPMC.

Note: Temporary WPMC membership is not full WPMC membership and you will not be entitled to any benefits that WPMC members are entitled to such as reduced entry fees, complementary ticket, event access or support vehicle access sticker.

Note: You need to be a member of a club before you can get an MSA licence.

WE HIGHLY RECOMMEND MEDICAL COVER FOR ALL EVENTS: Streetcars and Streetbikes are the only facet of MSA motorsport where medical cover is optional in order to make racing more accessible for members of the public.

Benefits of being a WPMC member:

As a full paying members of the WPMC you will be entitled to reduced race entry fees as well as free access into the facility for almost all WPMC events including drag days. A support vehicle access sticker will also be available to members for drag events on producing your member book at documentation.

Please note the following procedures you need to do in order to get a MSA licence.

1. You need to be a member of an MSA affiliated club – For this you can join the WPMC temporary membership for street drags (no cost) while the WPMC Club drag competitors need compulsory WPMC membership.
2. Take you proof of membership to the MSA office (located at Killarney), fill in the MSA licence application form (3 pages). The licence fee is R300.
3. MSA Medical insurance is available at a cost of R285 or written proof of personal cover for high risk sports from your relevant medical insurance company needs to be produced. Street Drags highly recommended.
4. MSA will then issue you with your 2010 licence card valid until the end of the year – 31st December 2010. This licence will be valid for all MSA drag racing / Streetracing events at Killarney including Gymkhana events.

Please note that it is best to come to Killarney to get your licence well in advance and between the hours of 9am till 1pm week days.
